

Please review the following information prior to submitting a nomination

CRITERIA FOR INDUCTION

Induction is restricted to three categories: **Athletes**, **Builders of Sport** and **Sport Teams**.

An individual connected with any sport, who has attained significant recognition and/or fame in or for the Haliburton Highlands, over a period of five (5) years or more, is eligible. Haliburton Highlands refers to the boundaries of the County of Haliburton, Ontario.

An athlete must have been retired from active participation in the sport(s) for which they are nominated for a period of at least (3) years or if still active, have attained the age of forty (40).

Builders shall be eligible at any time. There shall be no waiting period for this category even though the nominee may still be active in the role(s) for which they are nominated.

Teams shall be eligible at any time. There shall be no waiting period.

In order to be considered for induction, written nominations and supporting documents are to be forwarded to the Secretary of the Haliburton Highlands Sports Hall of Fame by the deadline date posted on the website. Induction will take place on a biannual basis. Incomplete information may make the nomination incomplete for that year.

INDUCTEE CLASSIFICATIONS

ATHLETE

To be considered for admission to the Hall of Fame, athletes must have been a resident of Haliburton County for a minimum of five (5) years before or during their sporting accomplishments.

To be considered for admission to the Hall of Fame, athletes shall have been or be outstanding in their respective sport or have achieved better than average proficiency in a number of sports (even if not reaching the absolute top level in any one sport). The level 'outstanding' must be applicable to competition against peer athletes over a period of at least five (5) years or more.

Competition involves competing at local levels and going on to district, regional, provincial, national and/or international events. Competition at the High School, Junior, College, and University or Professional sports levels should be included. Distinction should be made on the nomination form as to the reason for the nomination. An athlete who is prominent locally over a long period of time should not necessarily be downgraded if they have limited success at a higher level or in the professional ranks. Conversely, an athlete who has limited success locally should not be downgraded if they proficiency in a wider area whether this is at the amateur or professional level.

In selecting an athlete, the Committee shall consider the athlete's ability, level of success and accomplishment, sportsmanship and overall contribution to their sport(s) or teams.

BUILDER

A builder shall include, but is not limited to, any coach, manager, trainer, game official, executive member, administrator or sponsor.

To be considered for admission to the Hall of Fame as a builder, the individual shall have worked in the sport(s) over a period of ten (10) years of more and shall have been considered outstanding, whether this be in the organization of leagues and facilities, keeping a team or league active or having a high degree of success in coaching or managing teams or individual athletes.

Work over a sustained period of time must have been of a consistently high level with respect to services provided or results achieved.

In selecting a builder the Committee shall consider the builder's character, sportsmanship and overall contribution to their sport(s), team(s) or league(s).

TEAMS

A team shall include any team based in Haliburton County or any municipality within Haliburton County. Minor sports teams, High school teams, junior sports teams and adult sports teams competing at any level are eligible for admission to the Hall of Fame.

To be considered for admission to the Hall of Fame as a team, the team shall have achieved a high degree of success at the local, district and provincial level. Team success at the regional and particularly at the provincial levels are notable, however teams which have had a long period of success over many years at the local level should also be considered.

In selecting a team, the Committee shall consider the degree to which the team best represented excellence and sportsmanship while generating a high degree of community pride in the team's success.

NOMINATION INFORMATION SHEET

If you believe your nominee meets the conditions outlined in the criteria and classification sections above, please proceed. Be sure that your facts are accurate. The Selection Committee will substantiate your information.

In addition to the completed nomination form, the following material is to be submitted:

- 1. Supporting documentation which could include: copies of newspaper articles, clippings, citations and or certificates that describe the nominees sporting achievements, records, awards and contributions.
- 2. Statistical data which outlines the nominee's or team's achievements which could include: records set, highest levels of competition district, provincial, national, international and **championships won.**
- 3. Photographs: Individual head and shoulder photos and or action shots if possible for athletes and builders and Team photos for team nominations
- 4. Character letter(s) supporting the nomination. The letters could be submitted by teammates, fellow competitors, coaches, managers and or fans who watched the athlete or team compete or have knowledge of the builder's contributions.
- 5. Potential sources of additional information about the nominee: websites, YouTube or other video links.

Place the material in an organized folder and/or three ring binders for easy examination.
